

St. Alphonsus SCRIP FAQ

Will I be able to pay for my order with cash or check? All payments will be securely completed through the Raise Right site via bank withdrawal or credit card. At checkout, you are given the option to pay the Scrip coordinator as well. There will **NOT** be an option for cash payment.

Are physical gift cards still available? YES! The online platform allows you to select a retailer and then indicates what forms of cards are available. If you choose physical cards, they will be delivered to SCRIP coordinator who can set up pickup with you.

Will SCRIP cards be available after Mass? As we reintroduce SCRIP back to parishioners, we will have a SCRIP table in the Community Room for the rest of 2022. We will re-evaluate at the end of the year.

When will SCRIP orders be placed? SCRIP orders can be placed anytime on-line! E-cards and reloads are most times available immediately. (As long as you use banking information for payment) Physical card orders will be placed by coordinator on the 10th, 20th, and 30th of each month. The cards are delivered to coordinator 2-3 days later. Please plan accordingly for your needs.

When will SCRIP rebates be paid to participating families? The rebate year runs from January 1 through December 31. Rebates will be issued in January. Rebates will be disbursed at the rebate percentage of 50% of the rebate dollars earned.

Who can I donate by rebate dollars to? You may indicate any school family, St. Alphonsus School or St. Alphonsus Parish. You may also opt for a “cash back” as long as the earnings are over \$50.

Are my Scrip earnings tax deductible? If you choose to contribute your portion of the rebates earned to Church or School, you would be able to claim a deduction. Tuition, donation to a family and cash back are not tax deductible.
