

## St Alphonsus Scrip Program Changes

**As of September 14th, 2020 the St Alphonsus Scrip Program will be available as an online ordering platform ONLY.** From the convenience of your computer or smart phone you will be able to order and pay for Scrip gift cards to earn money towards tuition, parish , school, or now the option of cash back in the form of a check.

There will also be a change to how the rebate is distributed to those who participate in the program. **St Alphonsus Parish School will split rebate proceeds 50/50 with each participating family.** This change in rebate profits has the possibility to put more rebate dollars in participant's accounts!

How Scrip works:

Once registered to the program from the website Shopwithscrip.com, participants order gift cards in the form of physical cards, e-gift cards that can be downloaded to your smart phone or printed from your computer, or reload qualifying gift cards. Those retailers that are ordered from pay back a percentage of what is purchased in the form of a rebate. Rebates range from 2% to 18% or more, depending on the retailer and scrip promotions applied at the time of ordering.

When you sign up for the program and fill out the St Alphonsus Scrip Agreement Form you have the opportunity to decide how your rebate will be distributed as follows:

**Always, 50% of the qualifying rebate goes to support St Alphonsus Parish/School**

**The remaining 50% of the qualifying rebate goes to the designated participant as one of the following:**

- **Contribution to St Alphonsus General School Fund(tax deductible)**
- **Contribution to St Alphonsus General Parish Fund (tax deductible)**
- **Tuition credit for St Alphonsus School**
- **Tuition check payable to any other parochial grade school or high school**
- **Cash back**

Rebates will be distributed the beginning of each calendar year.
